



#### N <GO> | News Searches


Type key words in the yellow search box and wait for the dropdown to pick the most specific key word, topic, security, person or source, including Bloomberg and most international news providers, newspapers and social media. Use quotation marks to search for exact words or phrases in stories. Narrow your search by typing more key words. Simply type your preferred source in the yellow box and pick it in the dropdown.

- Click Actions > Use

#### TWTR <GO> | Twitter Filter Builder

Twitter is fully integrated with Bloomberg's monitoring, searching and alerting capabilities. Build a filter to see only the tweets you need.



- Type "TWTR" and hit <GO>.
- Click the page icon to the right of any featured topic

   including countries and regions, government and politics, industries and markets – to copy the list of suggested handles on that topic to My Lists and edit.
- Click the pencil icon to the right of the list to edit: rename, add or subtract handles.
- Or click **Create List** on the red toolbar to build a list from scratch.

#### MYN <GO> | My News Page


Create, edit and display personalized news pages to see specific topics, regions or markets.



- Actions > Create New Page.
- Enter a title and hit <GO>.
- For a new news search, in the amber field, type the key word(s) for a topic, security, person
  or news source > select from the list that appears. Specify how many stories you want to
  appear on your page.
- Click **Use Saved Search** to select from your **Saved Searches**.
- Click **Remove Search** to choose a new one and click **Delete Section** if you need.
- Click Save.
- Click **Add Section** on the red toolbar to add another filter, or **Reorder Sections** if required. Each section will display the most recent results each time you access the MYN <GO> My News page.
- Click **<Back> to Return** at the top of the page to save your edits.
- On the red toolbar, click My News Pages > Manage Saved Pages to reorder your pages.

## BI <GO> Bloomberg Intelligence

See extensive research on industries, companies, credit, governments, litigation, and strategies, including critical themes and reviews/previews of company earnings and data.




- Click **Browse** top-left to dig into BI's research by industries (more than 135), topics, strategy and BI products. Click the **All Regions** dropdown top-right to filter by region.
- Click on a topic to see its **Dashboard**: explore analysis of industries, markets, strategies and companies. From the categories on the sidebar, delve into an array of content, including company primers, earnings reviews, and assessments of important themes, as well as industry- and company-specific fundamentals and third-party datasets.
- Click the pencil icon right of **My BI** to create a list of favorite dashboards and data modules, to access in one click from the homepage.
- Click Actions > Contributors to find more than 300 contributing partners, and view research on your industry offered by third-party dataset providers and curated by BI analysts.

#### Tip

Click **Community** to connect with 300 BI analysts by signing up for a series of live or virtual events. Join a range of industry chatrooms with the relevant BI analyst and your peers.


• Click in the **blue search box** (also known as the **Command Line**) at the top of the screen > type key word(s) to find things > hit **Enter** or **<GO>**...

• Or type the key word(s) in the **blue search box** and wait for the dropdown suggestions:



#### Tip

If you click on a security, you'll get the option to open a range of data, news and research pages. We call these "functions". The options vary depending on whether you clicked on an equity, bond, currency, commodity, index, etc. We'll return to this on the next page.

#### **SECF < GO> | Securities Finder**

If you struggle to find a security by typing in the command line, try SECF <GO> to filter securities by asset class and a range of criteria such as industry, country, security type and keyword.



 Click the Category dropdown to select and asset class. Note the tabs that reveal further subcategories such as asset type

#### Tip

Search results appear in order of highest relevance, the most likely matches. A company that is currently popular in the news is likely to have a high relevancy rating. You can also sort results according to your own security-specific criteria by clicking the column headers that appear.

## Let's "load" an equity

Type the name of any company in the blue search box > wait for the dropdown suggestions > click the equity you want to analyze > note the range of data, news and research pages, or "functions". Here's an example of the dropdown options for an equity, Tencent Holdings Ltd.



- Click any of the options or drill deeper for more by clicking the category headings, Company Overview, Company Analysis, Research & Estimates, and so on.
- Click the Related

## First, functions that apply to all securities

#### **DES <GO> | Security Description**


Access a wide range of information about the security.



• Click the tabs to dive deeper.

#### **GP < GO > | Line Chart**

Chart a security's past performance, so you can detect trends and figure out why prices changed.



- Click Compare on the red toolbar to contrast your chosen security with a benchmark index, for example.
- Click in the date fields top-left to customize the range.
- Click Last Px to change to another data series, for example, estimated earnings.
- Click the **Daily** dropdown to pick another periodicity.
   Click the checkbox and pencil icon next to
   **Mov Avgs** to add or edit moving averages.

#### CN <GO> | News

Get the latest news tagged to this security.



- Type key word(s) in the yellow search box top-left to narrow the filter.
- Edit the news sources, date range and language top-right.

#### **HP <GO> | Historical Price Table**

See the last price and trading volume for equities.



- Choose your preferred periodicity in the **Period** dropdown.
- Note very useful data top-right: the high, low, average, plus net and percentage change for the chosen date range in the yellow boxes top-left. The default is 12 months, but you can change it.

#### **HCP <GO> | Historical Price with % Chg**

See the last price, plus net change and percentage, and the same data for trading volume for equities and commodities. The data you get varies slightly for other asset classes, such as currencies and bonds.

#### **HCPI <GO> | Historical OHLC with % Chg**

See the Open, High, Low and Close, with percent changes for all.



- Choose your preferred periodicity in the **Period** dropdown.
- Note very useful data top-right: the high, low, average, plus net and percentage change for the chosen date range in the yellow boxes top-left. The default is 12 months, but you can change it.

## **Equity-specific functions**

#### FA <GO> | Financial Analysis

Comprehensive financial information, including historical fundamental data and future estimates.



 Click the tabs for more detailed information on the balance sheet, income statement, cash flow, ratios and more.

#### **OWN <GO> | Ownership Summary**

Information on institutional and insider holders whose trading activity may influence the price. Identify holder groups that have the most securities, analyze which holders have large buying and selling positions, and which investors are building or unwinding positions. Trace ownership by type, geography, investment objective.

   such as the amounts held,

- Click Historical to study a holder's investment in the security over previous quarters. Trace patterns of ownership, estimated holding periods, current market values, and costbasis calculations.
- Click **Debt** to see the company's creditors. Filter by asset class, currency of the debt, coupon, maturity, etc.

#### **EE <GO> | Earnings & Estimates**


Aggregates broker earnings projections, surprise earnings data, and earnings history to give you a comprehensive snapshot of earnings estimates. Scan current metrics and estimates including Bloomberg's customizable consensus estimates (BEst), pricing data, and earnings.



- Click any data point to get a breakdown of current and past statistics. See how the data was derived, along with a list of suggested functions to continue your analysis.
- Click ERN | Earnings History, EEO | Consensus Overview, ANR | Analyst Coverage, EEO | Consensus Overview for related screens that go into more detail. ANR <GO> Analyst Recommendations tracks the latest analyst sentiment and over time and the performance of analyst recommendations. See lists of analysts' recommendations, price targets, price target time periods, and the consensus rating.

#### **RV <GO> | Relative Value**

Benchmark performance against peer groups, as classified by Bloomberg Intelligence, the Bloomberg Industry Classification Standard (BICS), or a range of external classification systems.



#### MGMT <GO> | Company Management

See who runs a company and find details on executives, board, committees, changes. Find out how a company performed during the tenure of top executives, past and present.

   Management
- Select **Show Management History** to see which
  executives delivered the
  best returns to shareholders
  and how their performance

#### **DDIS <GO> | Debt Distribution**

Load an equity > from the main **Related Functions Menu** > click the **Company Overview** > **DDIS | Debt Distribution** to display the maturity distribution of outstanding debt and analyze the debtor's ability to meet obligations. Display outstanding debt (bonds, loans, or both) by maturity, payment rank, coupon type, redemption type, or loan type, and choose the issuing entities, and the type of bond and/or loans included in the analysis.



#### **DVD** | **Dividend/Split Summary**

Load an equity > from the main **Related Functions Menu** > click the **Company Overview** > under **Capital Markets & Corp Actions** > click **DVD | Dividend/Split Summary** to display a history of a company's distributions to assess its commitment to pay dividends and spot investment opportunities. The history includes cash dividends and other distributions, such as stock splits.

## **Bond-specific functions**

First, how to find corporate bonds, say for Coca-Cola:

• Type "Coca Cola" in the command line:



• In the autocomplete dropdown, click **KO Corp** ("Corp" signifies bond(s) and "Equity" signifies stock) to launch a filter of all Coca-Cola's bonds in another function, **SECF <GO>**:



- Alternative method: load the stock by clicking KO US Equity > then type RELS + <GO>
  to see the Related Securities page or function > click Bonds & Generic Tickers.
- Click the bond you want. The relevance indicator on the left typically shows the most commonly watched security. In this case, Coca-Cola's 2.125% yielding bond maturing September 6, 2029. Let's click that one.



#### Tip

Note the so-called **Quote Line** at the top of the screen identifies the bond by the ticker ("KO"), coupon ("2 1/8", in fraction format as is common in the U.S.) and maturity date (09/06/29). The dropdown menu reveals the data, research and news pages offered for corporate bonds, including the standard options such as **DES** and **GP**.

#### **DDIS <GO> | Debt Distribution**

Load a bond > from the main **Related Functions Menu** > click the white **Descriptive** category heading > click **DDIS | Debt Distribution**.



- Display the maturity distribution of outstanding debt and analyze the debtor's ability to meet obligations.
- Display outstanding debt (bonds, loans, or both) by maturity, payment rank, coupon type, redemption type, or loan type, and choose the issuing entities, and the type of bond and/ or loans included in the analysis.

Load a bond > from the main **Related Functions Menu** > under the **Ratings Functions** category > click **CRPR | Credit Rating Profile**.



 Display current and historical credit ratings from ratings agencies on one screen to analyze the issuer's credit worthiness.

## **Currency-specific functions**


Type, for example, "pound" and click GBP Curncy in the autocomplete dropdown.



- Note the data, research and news pages offered for currencies, including the standard options such as DES, GP and CN.
- Among those, try FXFR |
   Spot/Forwards Monitor:
   Analyze spot and forward exchange rates for a selected currency pair.

## Commodities-specific functions

Type "**crude oil**" in the command line and click **CLA Comdty** to see the menu for the active crude oil contract.



- Note the data, research and news pages offered for currencies, including the standard options such as DES, GP and CN.
- Among those, try CT |
   Futures Contract Table
   to monitor New York
   crude oil futures trading,
   including price, volume
   and open interest, for
   contracts through the next
   decade.

## Relative-value functions: Compare equities worldwide

Press the yellow **Equity (F8)** key and hit **<GO>** for an overview menu.


#### **EVTS < GO> | Events Calendar**

Display a calendar of corporate events and corresponding details, including transcripts and audio recordings.



#### **WEI <GO> | World Equity Indices**

Monitor global equity markets in one page: performance, indexes, ratios, volume.



#### **MOST < GO> | Most Active Securities**

Find the biggest gainers and losers, most-traded by value, highest volume changes, stocks at a 52-week high or low and other outliers.



#### **IPO <GO> | Equity Offerings**

Monitor equity offerings by stage, region, industry and other criteria, analyze offering activity and performance, and identify investment opportunities. Define custom search and filter criteria, so you can quickly find the deals that match your investment and analysis objectives.



#### MA <GO> | Mergers & Acquisitions

Track and analyze mergers and acquisitions data, keep abreast of transactions in various regions and sectors, and easily filter for deals by criteria such as deal type, size, and adviser.



#### **EQS <GO> | Equity Screening**


EQS allows you to screen for companies that meet a customized set of criteria so you can generate investment ideas, create lists of securities to follow, and validate your trade ideas by seeing how they performed historically.



## **Commodities**

Press the yellow **Comdty (F9)** key and hit **<GO>** for an overview menu.

The links on the left and top-right offer data, research and analysis on commodities in general. For links on more specific commodity categories, for example coal, click one of the links marked with the yellow box in the image.



#### **GLCO <GO> | Global Commodity Prices**

Track global commodities, identify leading/lagging movers, using live price and volume data for the energy, metals and agriculture sectors.

#### **CPLY <GO> | Commodity Playbook**

Display the top 20 perennial commodity plays for oil, agriculture and metals.


#### **BMAP <GO> | Commodity Maps**

Query the Bloomberg Energy Database to generate maps for various commodity categories, including energy, vessels, mines, and rack pricing. For example, you can measure production and see ownership details for oil refineries in North America.



### **Currencies**

Press the yellow **Curncy (F11)** key and hit **<GO>** for an overview menu.



#### **FXIP <GO> | FX Information Portal**

Live currency prices, data, news and analytics categorized by countries, regions and precious metals.

#### FXC <GO> | Currency Rates Matrix

A matrix of cross-currency spot, forward and fixing rates. A heat map highlights trends and movements. Customize your regions, create and save custom currency baskets for fast access.

#### **FXFC <GO> | Foreign Exchange Forecasts**

Compare foreign exchange forecasts by a range of providers and relative performance plus a median consensus forecast. Forward rates to measure and rank the overall performance of forecasts.

#### WCR <GO> | World Currency Rates

Monitor this overview of currency rates in real time. Customize currency baskets, pricing options and display settings for fast access to currency rates.

#### WCRS <GO> | World Currency Ranker

Rank and compare currencies visually so that you can easily identify trends. Compare currencies based on returns, interest rates, volatility, carry trade, credit default swaps, and purchasing power parity.




#### **FXCA <GO> | Conversion Calculator**

Quickly convert one amount of currency into another using the current exchange rate or any closing rate in the past. See the applicable exchange rate.


#### **ECFC <GO> | Economic Forecast**

Display economic forecasts, so you can estimate future trends and compare forecasts for regions while reviewing the spreads between different regions, which gives you additional ways to identify trends in global economies.

#### **ECTR <GO> | Trade Flow**

An interactive trade flow map that allows you to see the export and import values between a selected country and its global trading partners. The data is provided by the International Monetary Fund Direction of Trade Statistics. You can backdate the data to determine whether trade between countries has increased or decreased and, overall, whether one country's trade imbalance is expanding or contracting.
